1. **Apologies:** Cllr. Alun Owen, Paul Weston.
2. **Present:** Cllrs: Gari Jones, Gerallt Jones, Edmund Rees, County Councillor Garffild Lewis and Enid Williams (Clerk)
3. **Code of Conduct:** No declaration of interest was declared.
4. **Minutes of February meeting** Edmund Rees offered as correct with Gari Jones seconding.
5. **Matters Arising from the Minutes:**
  - 5.1. BDO – still await answer to email.
  - 5.2. Amendment to data protection Legislation – Cllr. Garffild Lewis wanted to question Conwy to see if they could help us on this matter.
  - 5.3. Speed past school – Cllr. Garffild Lewis is liaising with Victor Turner for an explanation of the work they have suggested.
  - 5.4. CCBC – the repair to Bron Cadnant Bridge has been completed.
  - 5.5. CVC – confirmation that a grant of £500 to hold 2 sessions of play out during the summer holidays.
6. **Correspondence:**
  - 6.1. Cartrefi Conwy – advertises that an empty bungalow is available in the village for adults over the age of 55.
  - 6.2. Welsh Audit Office – a copy of a recent report on the management of governance in finance to local councils has been forwarded to the Councillors.
7. **One Voice Wales:**

A request from the association to join again this year at a fee of £46. It was proposed that we join and receive confirmation to pay the membership next month.

  - 11.1. At a cost of about £15 per sign Gerallt Jones proposed with Edmund Rees seconding that we proceed with the application and to also ask the Governing Body if they would support and pay for another 4 posters.
